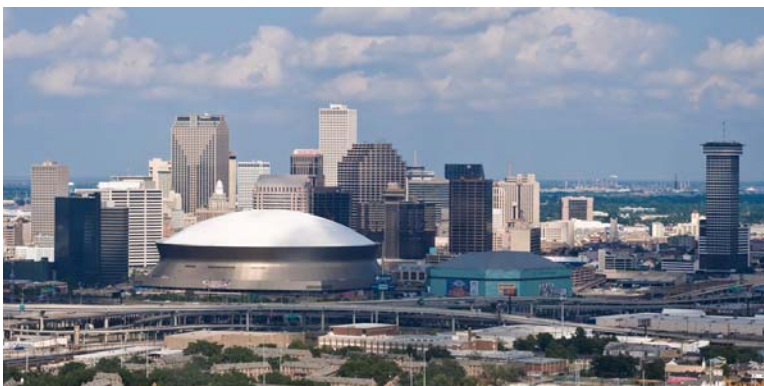

# NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA

## 9 Days - 8 Nights

*This sample itinerary is approximately the itinerary we will follow. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your trip.*

- Day 1 - A morning departure has you heading for your first overnight's lodging in Bristol, VA. Upon arrival you will visit the **Bristol Race Track**. After check in enjoy dinner on your own in the local area. *(Please pack an overnight bag.)*
- Day 2 - After breakfast, check out and continue to your next overnight stop in Birmingham, AL where you will visit the **Civil Rights Institute**. Dinner is on your own this evening lodging has been arranged for the group. *(Please pack an overnight bag.)*
- Day 3 - After breakfast, check out and depart for the **Cajun Country of New Orleans**, also known as the "**Big Easy**." Upon arrival, you will check into your motel. This evening you will enjoy a delicious dinner at one of New Orleans' popular restaurants.
- Day 4 - Enjoy breakfast, then depart on a **guided tour of New Orleans** and its historic sites. You will also enjoy a visit to the **National World War II Museum** which focuses on the contribution made by the U.S. to victory by the Allies in WW II and the Battle of Normandy in particular. The museum's main section focuses on the War in the Pacific and the War against Germany. There is also a special area on the Normandy Invasion and on Higgins Industries of New Orleans that designed and built the amphibious landing craft. The rest of the afternoon is free for you to explore the area at your own pace. Dinner will be at one of the popular restaurants in New Orleans this evening.
- Day 5 - Following breakfast, enjoy a tour of the **Houmas House Plantation & Gardens** — "The Crown Jewel of Louisiana's River Road." Sugarcane was farmed here on tens of thousands of acres, and it became the largest producer of sugar in the country. The mansion and grounds have been thoroughly restored and enhanced to reflect the opulent lifestyle and grandeur of the successful sugar barons who once lived here. Guides in period dress offer an entertaining glimpse into the resplendent world of southern plantation life through Houmas House. Spend the afternoon exploring some of New Orleans' attractions on your own. Enjoy some shopping and lunch on your own in the **French Quarter**, New Orleans' most popular neighborhood and one of the best preserved historical neighborhoods in America. The French Quarter features a strong, lasting Spanish and French influence and is home to the best-known party street in New Orleans ... Bourbon Street. This evening enjoy a cooking demonstration and dinner at the **New Orleans School of Cooking**.
- Day 6 - After breakfast, depart for **Harrah's Casino** where you can spend a few hours trying your luck at the slots and other games of chance. Afterwards, you will enjoy a spectacular **luncheon cruise aboard the Natchez** on the mighty Mississippi River. Later, you will visit **Café du Monde** for café au lait and beignets. Dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 7 - Enjoy breakfast, check out, travel to Atlanta, GA for overnight lodging *(Please pack an overnight bag.)* Dinner is on your own.
- Day 8 - Enjoy breakfast, then check out and visit the **World of Coca Cola** and the **Aquarium of the Americas** before departing for Bristol, VA for overnight lodging. Dinner is on your own in the local area. *(Please pack an overnight bag.)*
- Day 9 - Enjoy a continental breakfast, then check out and prepare for your departure home with lasting memories of your journey into the deep South, **Cajun Country of New Orleans**.
