

ITINERARY

Day 1 - Depart from my office in Shermans Dale, with pickups along the way, and travel to your overnight stop for lodging (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 2 - Following breakfast, check out and travel to Dandridge, TN to visit **Bush's Best Visitor Center** to learn about the history of Bush Best beans. Later, continue traveling to Chattanooga, TN. Tucked between the mountains of Southeast Tennessee, along the beautiful Tennessee River, Chattanooga is one of America's most breathtaking cities and has been voted as one of the "Top 45 Places to go" in the World. Upon arrival you will check into your hotel. Dinner is included this evening.

Day 3 - Enjoy a delicious breakfast, then depart for Blue Ridge, GA to enjoy a ride on the **Blue Ridge Railway**. Starting at the historic depot in downtown Blue Ridge, Georgia, riders take a four-hour, 26-mile roundtrip journey along the Toccoa River through the North Georgia countryside. The first leg of the adventure takes riders on a one-hour trip to the quaint sister towns of McCaysville, Georgia and Copperhill, Tennessee, nestled deep in the mountains on each state's line. Passengers enjoy all the towns have to offer during a two-hour layover before taking the one-hour return trip through the scenic forest and back to the depot in Blue Ridge, Georgia. After your ride, return to Chattanooga. At days end, enjoy a great dinner with beautiful scenery aboard the **Southern Belle Riverboat**. The Southern Belle Riverboat is one of the top attractions in Chattanooga. Enjoy dinner while cruising down the TN River and enjoying picture-perfect views of Lookout Mountain and all the beautiful nature this great city has to offer!

Day 4 - After a delicious breakfast, you're off on a great adventure aboard the Missionary Ridge Local, which is part of the Tennessee Valley Railroad. The term "Local" refers to shorter trains that were once a lifeline to small towns along the railroad. **The Missionary Ridge Local** trips begin at the Grand Junction depot and take passengers along one of the original railroad lines into Chattanooga, crossing bridges and diving through the Missionary Ridge Tunnel. The train stops at East Chattanooga, allowing riders off the train to watch the locomotive rotating on a turntable and participate in a tour of the railroad restoration shop before re-boarding for the return trip. After lunch on your own, depart for Lookout Mountain. Just minutes from downtown Chattanooga, TN, Lookout Mountain is the perfect destination for out-of-the-ordinary experiences and amazing natural wonders. Lookout Mountain is home to three top rated, world-famous attractions that showcase the natural and historic beauty of the area, each with breathtaking views of the Tennessee Valley. Trek through **Rock City's** natural wonders. A 100-foot waterfall that cascades down the mountain, and the famous **Swing-A-Longbridge** that spans nearly 200 feet, Lover's Leap, and the Fairyland Caverns. Then ride the **Incline Railway** up historic Lookout Mountain - the world's steepest passenger railway. In operation since 1895, the Incline is a National Historic site and Mechanical Engineering Landmark. Dinner is included tonight.

Day 5 - Enjoy a delicious breakfast, then check out and depart for overnight lodging in Pigeon Forge (pack an overnight bag). Arrive in Downtown Gatlinburg to enjoy lunch on your own and free time to visit the shops and explore the area. Afterwards, check into your hotel in Pigeon Forge and freshen up before departing for a Southern-style dinner. Afterwards, arrive at the **Red Skelton Tribute Theatre** to relive the great memories of the "Golden Age of Television" and pay tribute to "America's Clown Prince" - Red Skelton.

Day 6 - Following breakfast, check out and depart for home with fond memories of your trip to Chattanooga.
